ENTRY FEE	The OC will charge a fee of 60,00 € per person and night for every member of the delegation (double or triple room occupancy). If you book to stay from 26 th to 29 th the all-inclusive price is 170,00 €. The single arrangement is +10,00 per night per person. Additional persons (including coaches, judges and gymnasts, etc.) have to pay a fee of 70,00 €. For any additional nights and rates please contact the OC.
FAREWELL-PARTY	Gymnasts and accredited officials will receive a ticket for the farewell-party at the accreditation.


