TRAVEL EXPENSES	Each federation has to take over the travel expenses to Berlin by themselves. The organising committee will provide a shuttle service from/to the airport (Tegel (TXL) or Schoenefeld (SXF)) or alternatively to the train station.			
ENTRY FEE	The OC will charge a fee of 60,00 € per person and night for every member of the delegation (double or triple room occupancy). If you book to stay from 26 <sup>th</sup> to 29 <sup>th</sup> the all-inclusive price is 170,00 €. The single arrangement is +10,00 per night per person. Additional persons (including coaches, judges and gymnasts, etc.) have to pay a fee of 70,00 €.			
FAREWELL- PARTY	For any additional nights and rates please contact the OC.  Gymnasts and accredited officials will receive a ticket for the farewell-party at the accreditation.			
	All payments have to be on the account of the Berlin Gymnastics Federation by <b>February 15<sup>th</sup> 2015</b> . In case of overdue payments the entries cannot be considered.
